Driving events are still a work in progress with Regency Ramblers insurance for event in October taking months to get response from the insurance company.

General turmoil in some states in Australia with clubs leaving ASRF, is important NSW clubs do not lose all the hard work and funds to other states, a lot of work is going on in the background to ensure NSW rodders don't take unnecessary decisions.

NSW is ensuring that any matters relating to us are treated in transparent and democratic manner.

Cars Without Limits, it was pointed out to the President that they were not a charter club status and as such their status as a recognised club in NSW was revoked and their club details removed from ASRF national website.

The necessary paperwork will be submitted and approved and in general business delegates in attendance voted Cars Without Limits as a charter club.

Sydney Hot Rod show will be same arrangements as last year with a combined stand with NSW SRC.

- 4.** General discussion from more members on correspondence to head office not receiving acknowledgement or a response again.
- 5.** All clubs need to be aware of their club member numbers and membership. Please read and understand the following;

Under the ASRF requirements for affiliation all members of your club have to be members of the ASRF and understand members of a club with less than five members revert to "individual" membership. Clubs with less than seven members do not have voting rights on any matter at DC meetings. Clubs that do not meet these requirements are also not eligible for sanctions as insurance policy does not cover non ASRF members, whether they are a member of an affiliated club or not.
- 6.** John McCoy-Lancaster spoke to the floor about Ed Roth who passed with 7 of the family coming out for the Sydney Show plus the week before John has organised Richmond Classic Cruise-in on Sunday 18th May starting from Panthers Penrith, refer brochure attached with the Roth family involved and in the cruise.
