General Business:

Bill Relf spoke on his ongoing correspondence with head office / lawyers re requests from December, back and forth, still ongoing

A motion put forward re current issue due to head office's decision not to help cover the Professional Indemnity Insurance bill now required for the NSW street Rod Committee – since this coverage is no longer provided by ASRF Ltd there is a concern about whether ASRF members in NSW will continue to register their cars as easily as before. To protect the interests of all ASRF NSW members and keep the NSW SRC as our TAC for Street Rod registration matters in NSW the following is proposed.

1. The NSW DC re-endorses the NSW Street Rod Committee as our TAC for NSW, seconded by Mario Azzopardi and Peter Czerny

2. The ASRF NSW DC will contribute 50% (approximately \$2,350) towards the cost of professional indemnity insurance coverage for the NSW SRC.

This support will allow the NSW SRC to maintain the level of service ASRF NSW members have always received and ensure continued co-operation for the benefit of NSW street rodders, seconded by Peter Czerny and Russell Wylie

All delegates present and on zoom passed in favour of both motions, with Troy Fewings abstaining from both motions

Emphasised again that all club and committee members **MUST** be financial ASRF members.
