### NSW Divisional Council Meeting – May 2026

Director Gary Stanley welcomed everyone and declared the meeting open. He took the opportunity to congratulate NSW Steward and long-time member of Jokers Wild on having Life Membership being conferred on him, for his many years of service to his club and the hobby. Well done, Joe.

Gary explained the Secretary Denis had a previous engagement, and Gary would take responsibility for the minutes. NSW Deputy Director Troy Fewings would chair the meeting. Mitch Wood, from Bent 8's would be tonight's Web Master.

Treasurer's Report \$61,598.65.

Gary apologised for not completing the Warren Gore transfer – had been job hunting. Expects to have this completed in the next 2 weeks.

New South Wales Street Rod Committee Report.

All's good. Troy was asked how the Street Rod Committee app for Apple phone users (in obtaining a permit number) was going. Troy said that Peter Trees who had been working on this, had recently relocated to Queensland. Troy commented that what was required to get this working for Apple phones was much more difficult than expected – and that this may not proceed.

ACMC Report. Nothing to report – meeting next week, March attached Deputy Director - The Regional Nationals in Canberra has been done and run. Financials were not available at the time of the meeting, but expectations were that the event would end up in the black.

Troy advised that a legal matter regarding an incident at a previous Yarrowonga rod run, which had been resolved, though specific details about settlement were unclear.

NSW Director Report – thanked all present for making time to attend the meeting.

Again – the meeting is an exchange of ideas – so please keep that in mind when discussing things.

He said that he believed that both the Narrandera run and Canberra run may have suffered from the increased cost of fuel (Iranian war) as well as some of the media were talking up the situation of regional towns running out of fuel on the weekend.

Bill and Kerry Relf have had their membership revoked the NCC and were served with legal papers. Currently they are on holidays stateside and will return to defend themselves next month.

A brief, but robust discussion was held with the consensus being surprised that Bill had been a long-time supporter of seeing the ASRF continue – not blow it up.

Reports: Buddy said that they had another successful run with good support. Comments that Narrandera was another excellent run, as was Canberra. There was a comment that it was unfortunate that both runs could not have been better supported.

General Business –

Maitland asked if, seeing as though NSW now has the equipment required for Zoom, could this be loaned to the Street Rod Committee? To be sent onto the Street Rod Committee for their input.

Any other business: Gary asked the meeting to consider if there was any interest in reducing the number of DC meetings held each year from 11 to 7.
