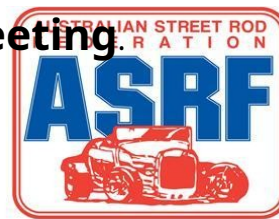

Directors Report:

Gary thanked those present and online for making themselves available for the meeting. He reminded everyone that the meeting was an exchange of ideas, and that no name calling would be tolerated.

Warren Gore Bequeathment:

After much discussion, an account has been established by Liberty Rodders in Warren's name. This agreement has proved to be the most workable. Thank you to the Street Rod Committee for your offer of support. The money will be transferred over the next month into this account.

Deputy Director's Report:

Troy spoke about the meeting held in Western Australia held last month. He said that there were approximately 25 people signed in (some brought partners who didn't sign in), and the event was mainly positive. It went from 2:00 pm – 5:30 pm.

Troy said that he has been advised that following the meeting, some people have indicated that they may be interested in working to establish a new organisation over there. More to come.

General Business:

- January Meeting – would there be a January meeting? It has proved to be popular, being a daylight event with plenty of room for parking. January 9th, 2027, has been pencilled in. Macquarie Towns have indicated that they are happy to cater for this event.
- Discussion switched to why the state did not proceed with a 7 meetings per year, as opposed to 11 – 12 meetings. Social meetings were seen as a more conducive way to introduce more people to the hobby. Gary said that that there were two clubs who had reservations about going to a reduced calendar, worrying that clubs would get out of the habit of making time to attend meetings.
- Another question was about the intention to attend other locations within New South Wales to hold weekend meetings. Even with Zoom, there is still an interest in proceeding with this.

Meeting closed 8:45 pm.
